

## 5th Annual Washington Fine Arts Festival - 2012

Saturday, August 11, 2012, 10 am to 5 pm & Sunday, August 12, 10 am to 5 pm

Washington Park, Washington, Illinois (From the Square go north on North Main, turn left on W. Jefferson, at the stop sign turn right on Lincoln and proceed to just beyond Lincoln School.) Set up will be Friday Aug. 10 from 6 pm to 9 pm, Saturday Aug. 11 from 6 am to 9:30 am, and Sunday Aug. 12 from 8 am to 9:30 am

**APPLICATIONS MUST BE POST MARKED BY MAY 5, 2012**

**ALL APPLICANTS WILL BE JURIED AT THE SAME TIME AND WILL BE NOTIFIED IN MAY.**

10' x 10' Booth space on grass \$75

\$10 non refundable jury fee in a separate check for ALL applicants PLUS a self addressed stamped envelope

### To become a qualifying artist:

1. All work shown must be the artist's own creative, original concept, design, and execution, and must be personally exhibited. Prints are allowed.
2. Along with the application, ALL applicants must submit 3 photographs representing work to be shown at the Festival plus a photo of the booth as it might appear in the festival. (In some cases this may not be possible.) Photos will be returned by mail if not accepted and at the event if the artist has been selected to participate.
3. Applicants will be juried at the same time and will be notified in early May.
4. Two or more applicants may share booth space at no extra charge and must apply together. Each artist must send three photos representing the work they will show at the festival.
5. Booth spaces are outdoor 10'x10' areas of grass. Each space rents for \$60. Applicants may rent one or more spaces as needed. Electricity is not available and generators are not allowed.
6. Exhibitors are responsible for setting up and attending to their own booths. If you need booth sitters for lunch etc. please indicate that on the application.
7. It is strongly suggested that each artist bring a white tent or at least an attractive, neat tent.....no tarps, please.
8. Each artist must provide all tables, chairs, and other props needed for displaying his or her work.
9. Artists must be present and have booth open for business during all hours of the 2 day event....No early tear down. Artists who tear down without permission from the Festival committee will not be asked back.
